

# Station Committee Meeting

01/03/10

The fire station committee met on Sunday the 3<sup>rd</sup> at 08:00.

Those in attendance were Kevin, John, Curt, Scott, Al, Chris C., Terry.

Items Discussed were:

Gear rooms, how many stalls? 50 was decided upon.

Should we put a radio, county map and telephone on the outside of a gear room? Yes we will look into it.

Do we need a set of double door to create a vestibule? Yes lets look at it.

Curt presented the current bids on S.C.B.A fill stations. Bid from Alex Air was \$8,700.00 and bid from Heiman fire equipment was \$5,303.00. We may attempt to build a fragmentation container locally.

The idea of needing a vacume cleaner for the new station was brought up. It will be added to the small appliances list.

John will contact Sheriff Weathington and EMA director Malott and check to see if they are still interested in setting up some equipment in the radio room to enable it to be a backup Cedar County Dispatch location.

Group was interested in putting a restroom where the janitors closet is located on the design. Curt will email Dale Solum on Monday.

Kevin expressed deep concerns with the location of the radio room currently on the design. The group felt that adding safety glass and window tinting would alleviate some of the issue.

The area where a storage close is locate on the design, North end West wall was discussed. Remove all storage closets and add a drain and overhead bay door to the North bay East wall was decided upon.

Use of pallet racks was approved instead of the storage closet.

Scott indicated he would like a second sink added to the woman's restroom. Group decided yes.

Al asked if we should pipe pnumatic lines to each apparatus bay? Much discussion was heard on the issue. Final was to look into the cost of one automatic rewind reel and four 50' sections of air hose.

Question of using the B/A compressor for tools use was asked. Curt will call Alex Air on Monday.

Kevin brought up that he would like to see the drinking fountain recessed into the wall on the apparatus bay. The group was in agreement.

1. Flagpole, sign and bell area will be cost analyzed and brought to the group by Curt.
2. Scott researched office furniture. He proposed cost from Hon. Scott would get more bids.
3. Appliances will be cost analyzed by Chris Cook.
4. A/V and I.T will be addressed by Curt
5. Terry will research weights and cardio equipment. Terry was told Brad would like to help.
6. The pressure washer will be cost analyzed by Al.
7. Kevin and Chris C will research cabinets, counter tops and lockers.
8. Scott and Kevin will look into gear racks.
9. Gear rooms will be researched and cost analyzed by Kevin and Chris C.
10. Tools and toolbox, Al brought two bids, one from Snap On and one from Sears. A third will be from NAPA soon.
11. Kevin and Chris C will research material and cost to acquire.
12. Curt has spoken to several on scanning, reprinting and framing historical pictures for the TFD. The reprints will adorn the new station walls.
13. Floor covering was left for Tory to investigate and bring suggestion back to the group.

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John did some research on the automatic flush urinals. The 12-volt style will need access to the back side of them for maintenance. The battery operated is simply stand-alone. The issue of the 12-volt not working in a power outage was discussed. An approximate price for the hardwire auto flush urinal was \$350.

Kevin asked if it is wise to start a group on a fundraiser for the new station. We anticipate that we will fall short of getting all of the items we need. Thus if we start a fundraiser now we may integrate the items we need right away as opposed to wait and see. The group did discuss the issue and it was left as if a Women's auxiliary were established it may be a project for them to under take.
